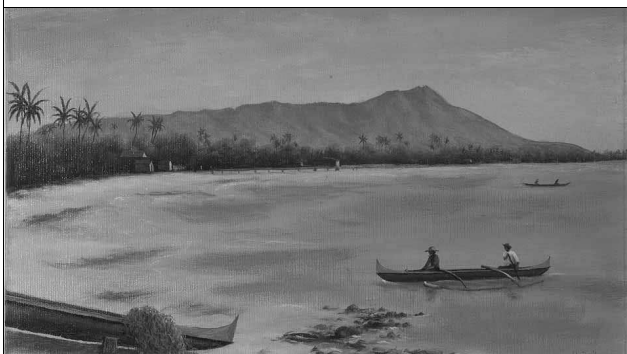

The Last Grass Huts at Lahaina

The old style grass house is rapidly becoming a thing of the past, and the two pictured here being the last in Lahaina. The logs for these huts were cut in the mountains near Lahainaluna Seminary. After the framework is up it is covered with pili grass and woven to the frame in heavy layers. When properly built, they are impervious to rain, and the floors, covered with the soft mats of old time Hawaiian manufacture, were very comfortable.

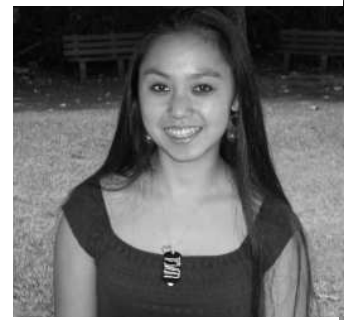

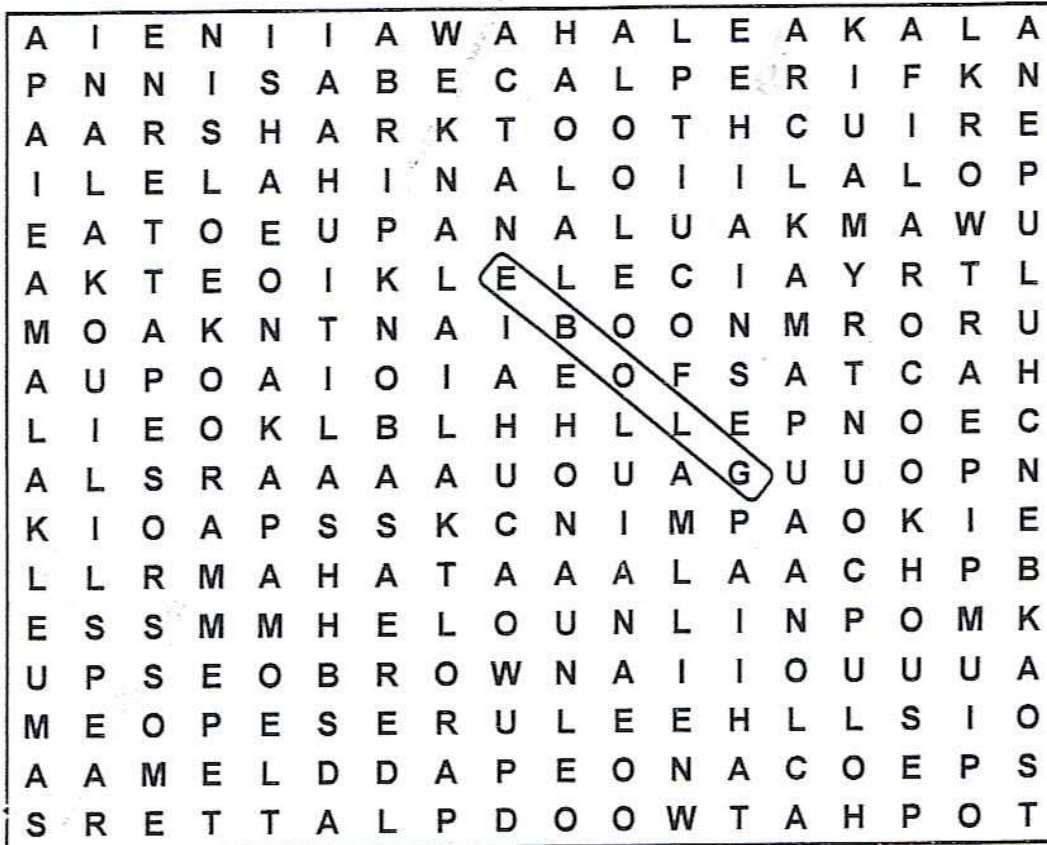
